EVENT	The team competition is based on IFSC invitation to the National Federations. The
INVITATION	invitation will follow the 2024 Team Ranking for Boulder and Lead, where the points of the two disciplined will be cumulated. National Teams will be invited to the competition and they will be required to provide an official answer by the deadline communicated by the IFSC. In case of refusal to participation, or missing answer, the IFSC will invite the next National Team available.
IFSC NATIONS GRAND FINALE QUOTAS	The IFSC Nations Grand Finale will award two set of medals: Lead and Boulder. Each National team will be composed by the following members:
	- Two (2) MEN athletes
	- Two (2) WOMEN athletes Each Country might decide to propose the same team competing in both Boulder and Lead disciplines, or to propose two different teams. The detailed rules of the event will be released during the oncoming weeks. Each National Federation could also register Team Officials in the maximum numbers and capacity following:
	a) one (1) Team Manager;b) four (4) coaches;c) two (2) qualified medical or para-medical personnel
	Licences : Only competitors and team officials with a valid IFSC international licence are allowed to register for the competition.
TEAM EVENT FORMAT BOULDER	The competition will be divided in different rounds: Qualification, Elimination heats and finals













	 For each round, the team will climb four boulders divided in pairs; every boulder will be climbed by two athletes of the same gender The fifth boulder shall be climbed by two athletes of different gender. It will be coach's responsibility to choose the athletes who will climb the boulder There will be a maximum time per team (or per athlete) to approach the boulders The maximum possible score for each boulder is 50 points (2 athletes * 25 points) The score of the team is provided by the sum of the different athletes' score, for all rotations The athletes can talk, share betas and information. They autonomously decide how to organize their climbing time. The coaches can talk with athletes 	
TEAM EVENT FORMAT	The competition will be divided in different rounds: Qualification and finals	
LEAD	 For each round, the team will climb two routes divided in mixed pairs. Each athlete will climb one route, the allocation of the athletes will be decided by the coach 	
	The score of the team will be given by adding the scores of each single athlete	
PARA CLIMBING MASTER	Open categories: UPDATES: The event will be open to all the IFSC Sport Classes.	
	It should be noted that the event will not strictly follow IFSC merging rules. Sport classes might be merged and combined depending on event needs. Lead wall will be able to host two routes for Para Climbing Qualifications.



Team Event - athletes' grants

The final contribution for each National Team will be confirmed at the registration deadline. The <u>minimum guaranteed contribution</u> is fixed to the following amount:

- Host Country / Team JPN = 1500€
- National Teams coming from the Asian Continent = 3500€ for each National Team
- National Teams coming from other Continents = 6500€ for each National Team

The contribution will be released by the IFSC to each National Federation. It should be noted that the contribution will not be based on the size of each National team.

Para Climbing event

The Para Climbing athletes attending the event will receive financial support. The financial support will be based on the number of athletes who will compete at the event. Therefore, the total financial support will be confirmed at the registrations deadline. However, to provide clarity to the participant athletes, the following table shall be used as reference:
