The IFSC EYC (Speed) is organized by the IFSC Europe & the German alpine club in accordance with the IFSC.

International speed regulations and the European Youth Cup Lead/Speed/Boulder rules are applied.

2 REGISTRATIONS

3. TEAM QUOTAS & RULES

Licenses:

Only competitors and team officials holding a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition.

Registration of team and competitors:

Member Federation may register, within statutory deadlines, team officials for one of the following roles:

- a) One (1) Team Manager
- b) Up to three (3) coaches per discipline
- c) Up to three (3) qualified medical or para-medical personnel

Member Federations may register as competitors:

- (a) Per Category
 - (i) U16 and U18
 - (i) up to three (3) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline
 - (ii) up to two (2) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline for the top ten ranked federations (ranking calculation like it is set out in IFSC-Europe Rules Art. 2.3)
 - (ii) U20
 - (i) up to two (2) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline
 - (ii) up to two (2) competitors for each Category in each relevant discipline for the top ten ranked federations (ranking calculation like it is set out in IFSC-E rules Art. 2.3)
- (b) the host federation shall be entitled to register an additional two (2) competitors in each Category for each relevant discipline.
- (c) up to two (2) competitors for each Category and gender in each relevant discipline for the African council

Registration Deadline:

Saturday, 16th September 2023 - 23:59 CEST

Registration Fees:

€ 25, - for each competitor per discipline.

The Registration fee will be invoiced by IFSC Europe to the National Federations. No cash-payments will be done on site. For the registration on site, it is necessary for all team managers to show the passports or ID-cards (or copies) of their competitors.

Table 1: Required Information for Invitation letter

Important to remember:

1. Make sure that each passport has two blank visa-designated pages.
2. Make sure that the expiry date of the passport is at least six months after the last day of the expected stay in Germany.
3. If the passport does not meet these two requirements, a new passport must be obtained or the existing one is to be prolonged before you can request the invitation letter.
