3. Deadlines and quotas

3.1. Registration deadline

- Registration Deadline: 10 days before the first day of the event, **Wednesday, 9th of September 2026 at 23:59 UTC.**
- Following the Registration Date and until 3 days before competition, Member Federations may withdraw Team Members and substitute new Team Members (within the same Category).
- Registration fees: **45 € per athlete.**
- In case of late registration please get in direct contact with Irem Baldini (europe.events@worldclimbing.com) to forward the athletes you want to register. A late registration surcharge of €95 will be applied for each competitor in addition to the standard registration fee.
- The registration fee will be invoiced by the World Climbing Europe to the National Federations. No cash-payments will be made on site.
- During the on-site registration, it is necessary for all team leaders to show the passports or ID-cards of their competitors (or copy).
